Student Voice

- 7 x Full-Time Officers
- 10 x Part-Time Officers
 - Representing specific groups of students
- Officers ensure the interests of Warwick students are at the heart of any decision-making

Elections

- All Full-Time and most Part-Time officers are elected in the Spring Elections
- Week long period of voting
- Campaigning on campus with posters / lecture shout outs, social media etc
- Campus-wide, all students will have a vote



Full-Time Officers

- 7 x Full-Time Officers
- Paid sabbatical position for a term of one year (August – August)
- Can be in between years of study or for after completion of study (we arrange this with the university)
- Representative role
- Trustee and leader of the Students' Union
- Limit of two terms

Part-Time Officers

- 10 x Part-Time Officers
 - Representing specific groups of students
- Only 7 elected in Spring Elections (International Students Officers + PT and Mature Students Officers elected in Autumn)
- Working Part-Time alongside their studies
- Liberation & Diversity Committee

Student Voice

- Academic Representation
 - 700+ Course Reps elected by students
 - Giving students a say on their academic experience
 - Reps take student feedback to Student Staff Liaison Committee (SSLC)
 - Training provided and support
